Malbec, Les Volets, Languedoc, France	£8.75	£11.85	£33.00
Vibrant ruby hues gleam out of the glass. Notes of crushed blueberries which develop to reveal an intriguing bitter-sweet character of crème de cassis with a touch of underlying parma violets.			
Aglianico, Montecalvo, Italy	£8.95	£11.95	£35.00
Intense dark fruit aromas with savoury hints. Fleshy bramble & plum character on the palate with ripe tannins & juicy acidity.			
Nero D'Avola, Ca Di Ponti, Italy	£7.85	£10.25	£29.00
A deeply coloured, full flavoured red with aromas of wild plum & black cherry. The robust palate combines abundant brambly fruit flavours with lightly spicy & savoury notes, a hint of bitter chocolate and structured ripe tannins.			
Malbec, Nieto Senetiner, Argentina			£38.50
A deep dense blockbuster from 40+ year old vines. The palate is silky & warming with black fruit & cherries. A vibrant wine with an alluring blend of fruit along with clove, pepper and cinnamon spice finished off with well-structured integrated tannins.			
Pinot Nero, Avamposti Ventura, Monferrata DOC			£42.50
Excellent Pinot noir from the cooler slopes of Il Cascinone. Distinctly varietal but with the structure & spice typical of Piemontese reds. An expressive, complex nose with wild raspberry and crunchy cherry aromas combined with darker, black fruits & a hint of spice. Ripe fleshy fruit is balanced by bright acidity. The finish is juicy & lightly savoury with soft, balanced tannins.			
Pinot Noir, Novas Gran Reserva, Chile	£9.95	£13.50	£38.50
Pale ruby red in colour with a lifted nose of raspberry, blackcurrant fruit and a gentle cranberry grip with subtle dark spice notes from barrel aging. It has a long and elegant finish			
Carignan, Alo Jais Noir, Cotes Catalanes	£9.65	£12.75	£37.50
Big, bold and concentrated, it leaves an impression. The small yields from this area and its unique soils and landscape give distinctive wines with personality. It's intense and complex with dark, rich fruit, delicate tannins and smooth mouthfeel.			
Ordinal Cabernet Sauvignon, Cotes De Thau, France	£8.75	£11.95	£34.50
A refreshing & fragrant Cabernet with fresh & bright flavours of blackcurrant. Silky textured, lifted on the mid-palate & with a smooth ripe finish.			
Garnacha/Syrah, Borsao Bolé, Spain	£10.95	£14.65	£42.50
Intense ripe plum & cherry aromas combine with sweet toasty oak on the nose. A rich, warm generous palate with concentrated blackberry fruit, backed by acidity & ripe tannins. Good concentration with coffee & spicy vanilla notes			
Rioja Seleccionada, Vega del Rayo, Spain	£8.65	£11.75	£33.50
Richly aromatic and complex, showing floral, ripe cherry, oak spice and mocha notes on the nose. The palate is succulent with rich red berry notes and fine tannins, supported with fine acidity and finishes with a long and balanced persistency.			
Barbera D'Asti Ceppi Storici, Araldica	£9.50	£12.50	£35.50
Warm, spicy aromas of blueberries and plums, with subtle, smoky notes. The palate is rich and generous with juicy cherry and more plum fruit, and meaty, spicy notes beneath. Soft oak tannins offer an extra dimension to the texture. A refreshing smack of fruity acidity on the finish gives plenty of definition to the ripe fruit.
